

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 in the Province of Saskatchewan  
RELATING TO THE PLANTING OF TREES OR SHRUBS OR THE PLACING OF STONE PILES AND OTHER OBJECTS ADJACENT TO CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.

The Municipal council of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay no. 342, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
  - (a) "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342, of Saskatchewan.
  - (b) "road" means any road allowance within the municipality other than:
    - (i) a private road, or
    - (ii) a provincial highway; or
    - (iii) a road or highway within hamlets
2. No person shall hereafter plant trees or shrubs or place stone, earth or gravel piles, portable structures machinery or other objects on private property within one hundred and fifty feet fro the centre line of any ~~the~~ road.
3. The council may, by order, direct the owner of any property upon which a tree or shrub has been planted or a stone, earth or gravel pile, portable structure machinery or other object has been placed in contravention of the provisions of section 2 thereof, to remove the same within a time to be stated in such order and the provisions of section 185 of the Rural Municipality Act, 1972 shall apply, mutatis mutandis, if the owner fails to comply with the order.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of section 2 hereof is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
